PLAN B VS. ABORTION PILL- BOTH CAUSE ABORTION

Differences between the morning-after pill and the abortion pill, which are different drugs:

The morning-after pill attempts to prevent pregnancy. Sold under the brand name **Plan B**, it's a higher-than-normal dose of a hormone found in regular birth-control pills and tries to prevent ovulation or fertilization of an egg. If the egg is fertilized (and a living soul is created) it will be prevented from implanting itself on the uterine wall. This "back up plan" is the same one used in regular birth control pills. Most women taking Plan B or regular birth control have no idea that they may unknowingly be aborting.

The abortion pill, RU-486 or Mifeprex, can terminate pregnancy up to 49 days after the beginning of the last menstrual cycle. It's a two-pill process. First is Mifeprex, which blocks production of a hormone required to sustain pregnancy. Then a second medicine, misoprostol, to cause contractions and finish the abortion.
